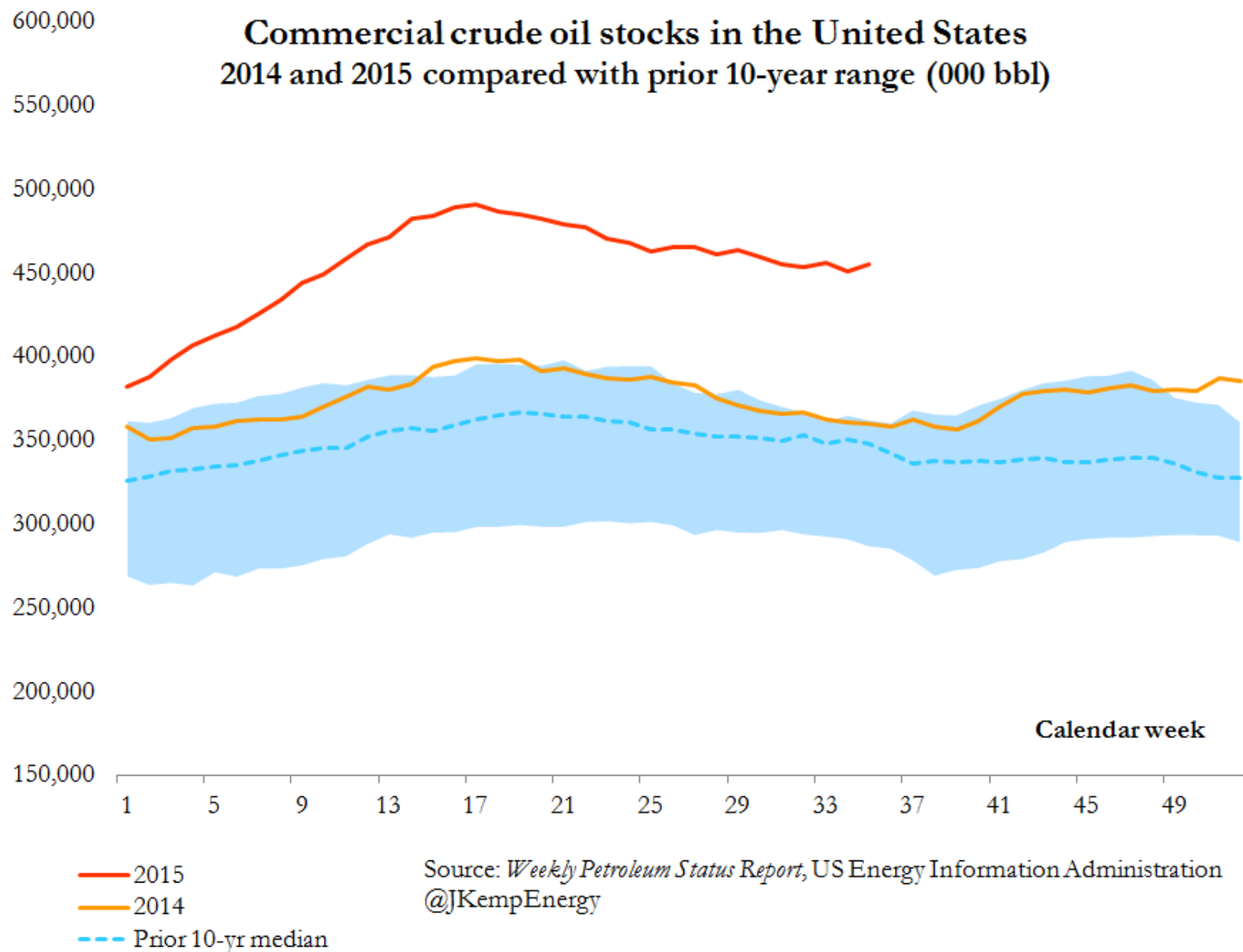

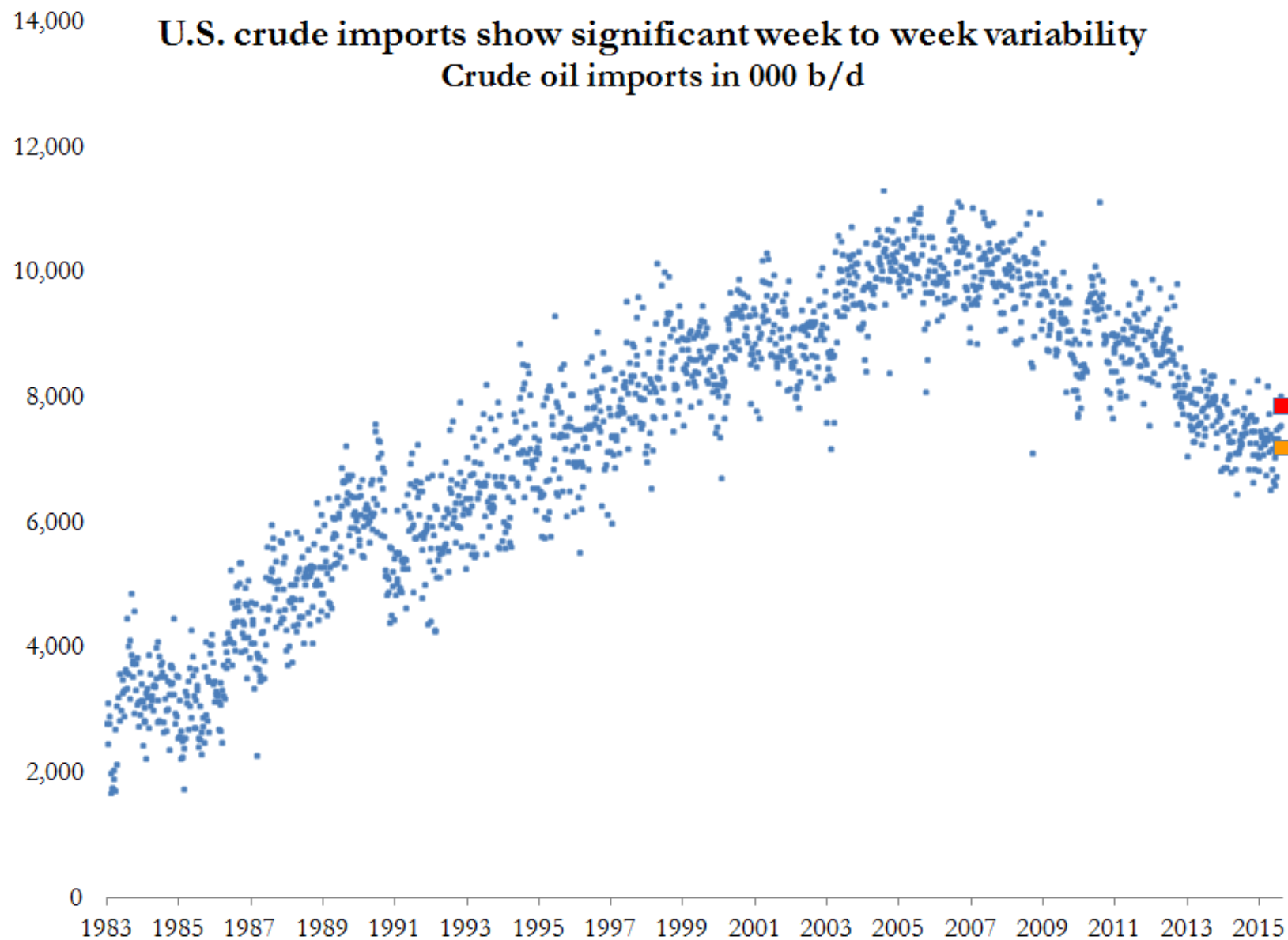

Commercial crude oil stocks in the United States 2014 and 2015 compared with prior 10-year range (000 bbl)

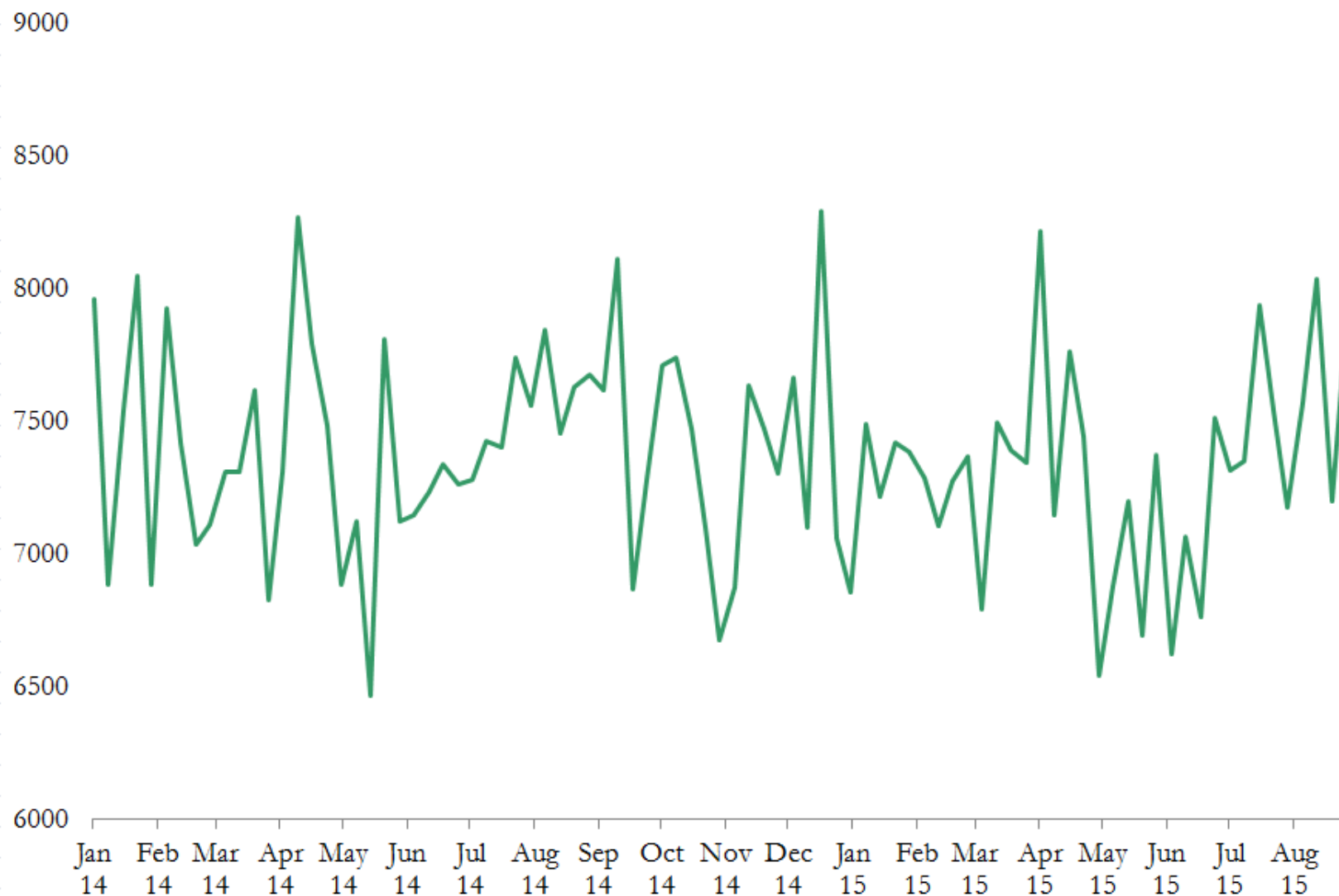

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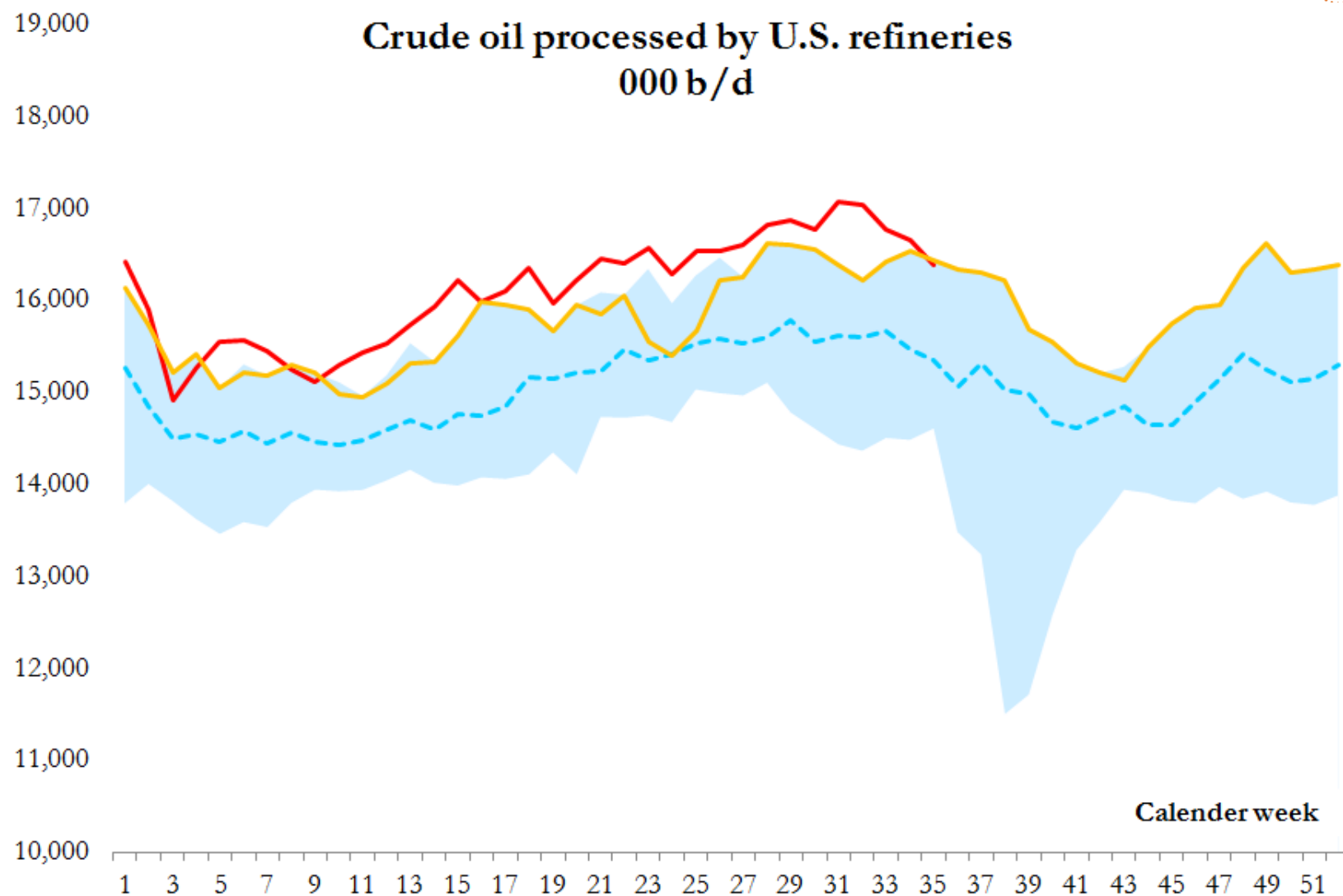
U.S. weekly crude oil imports (000 b/d)

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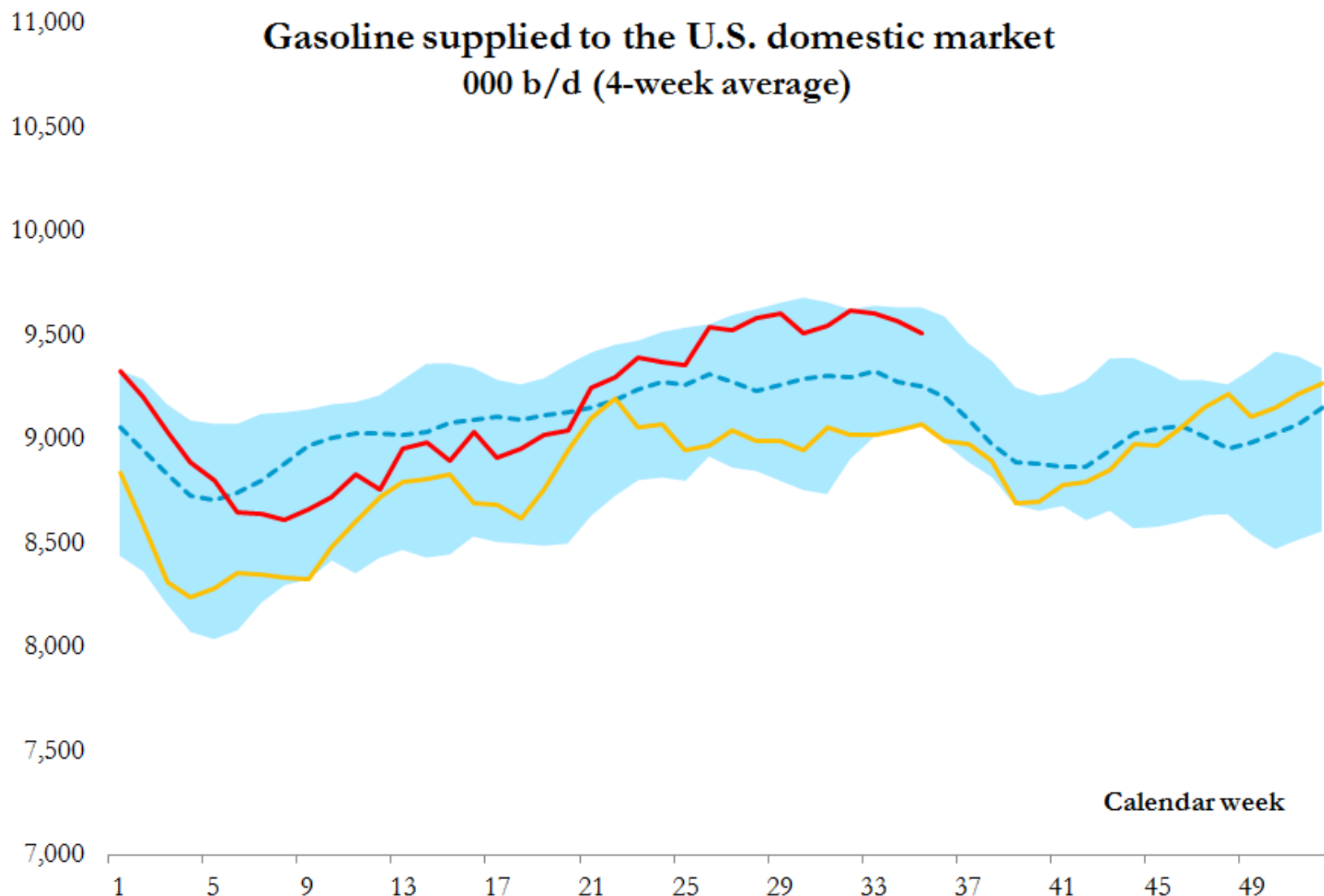
Crude oil processed by U.S. refineries 000 b/d

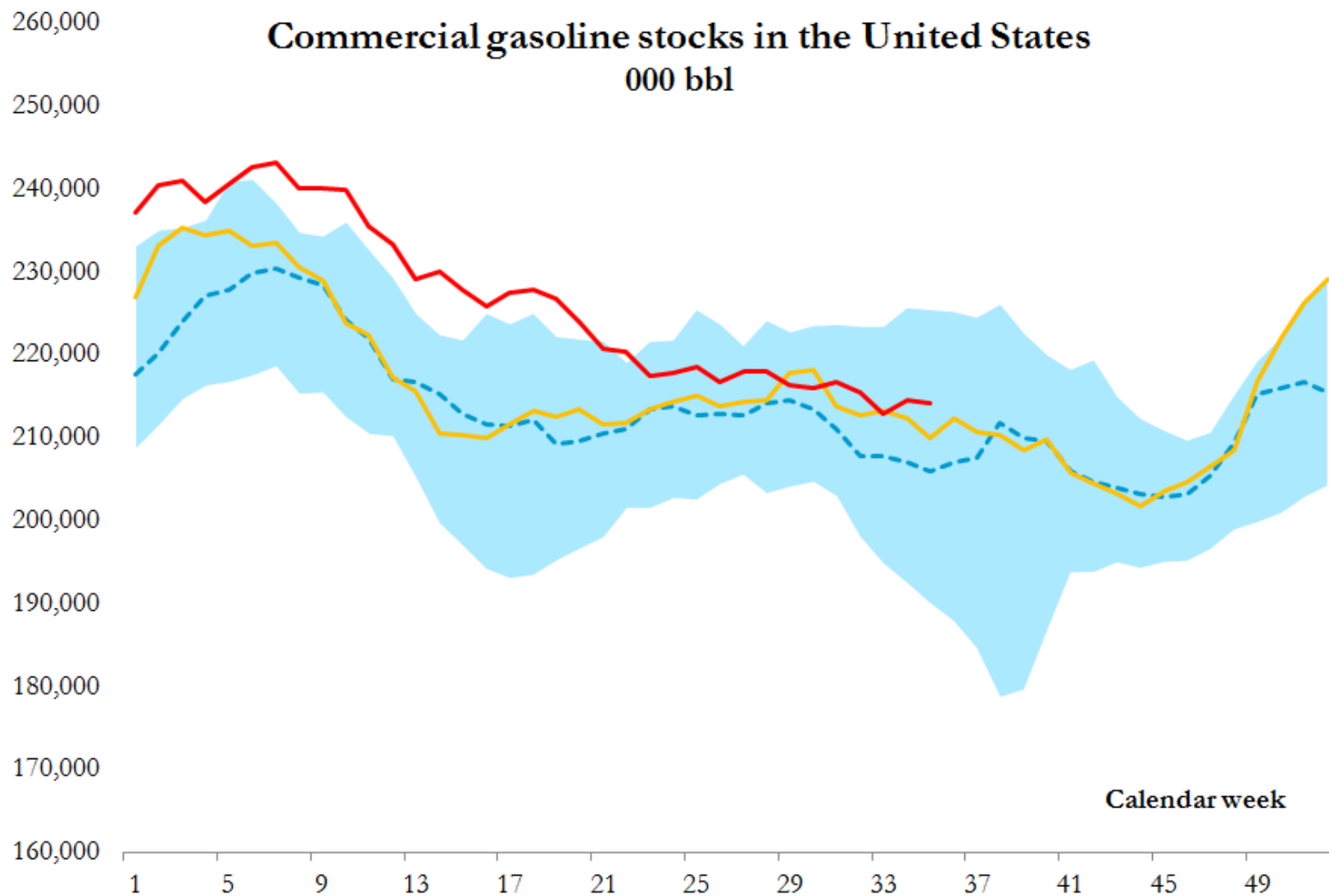

Commercial gasoline stocks in the United States

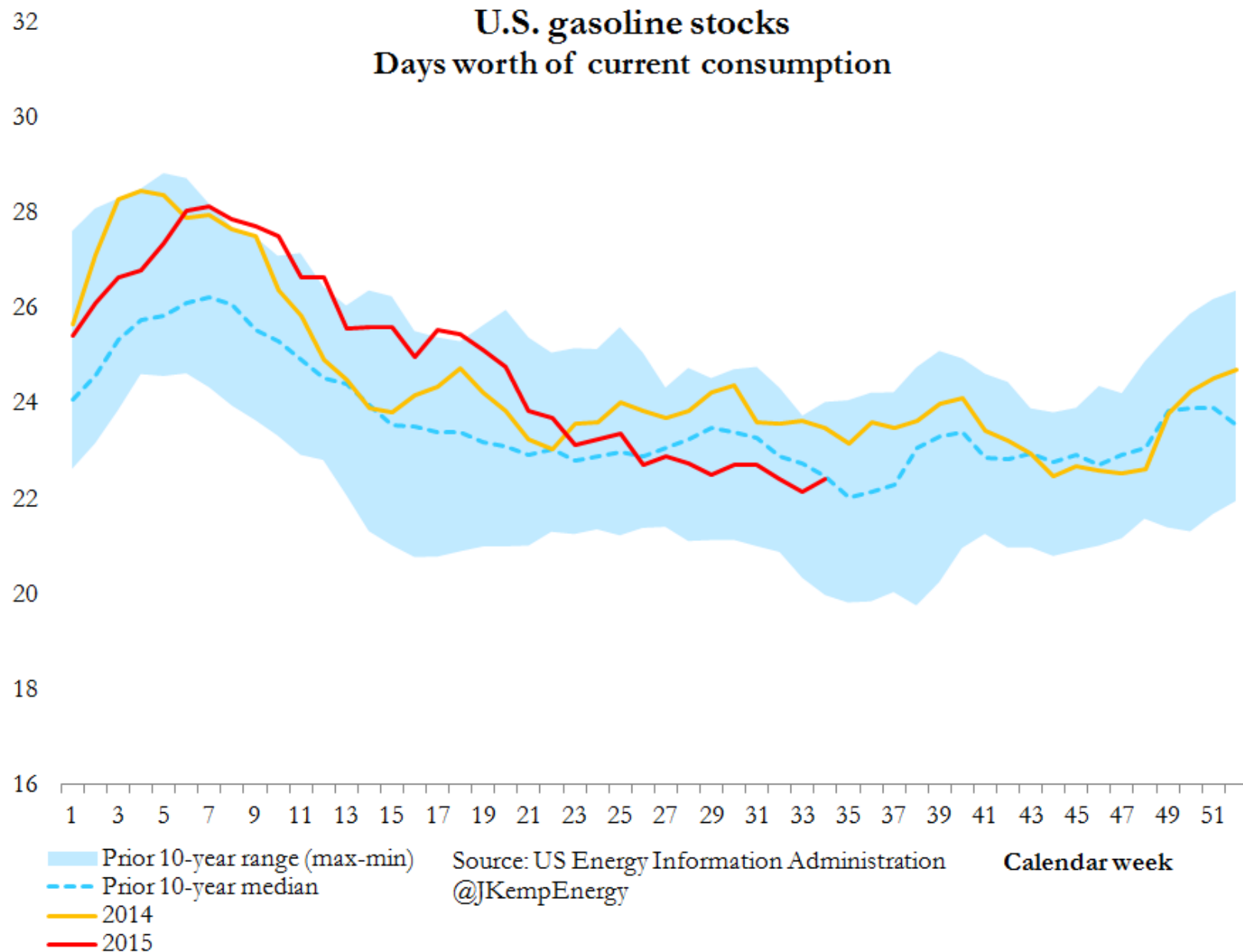

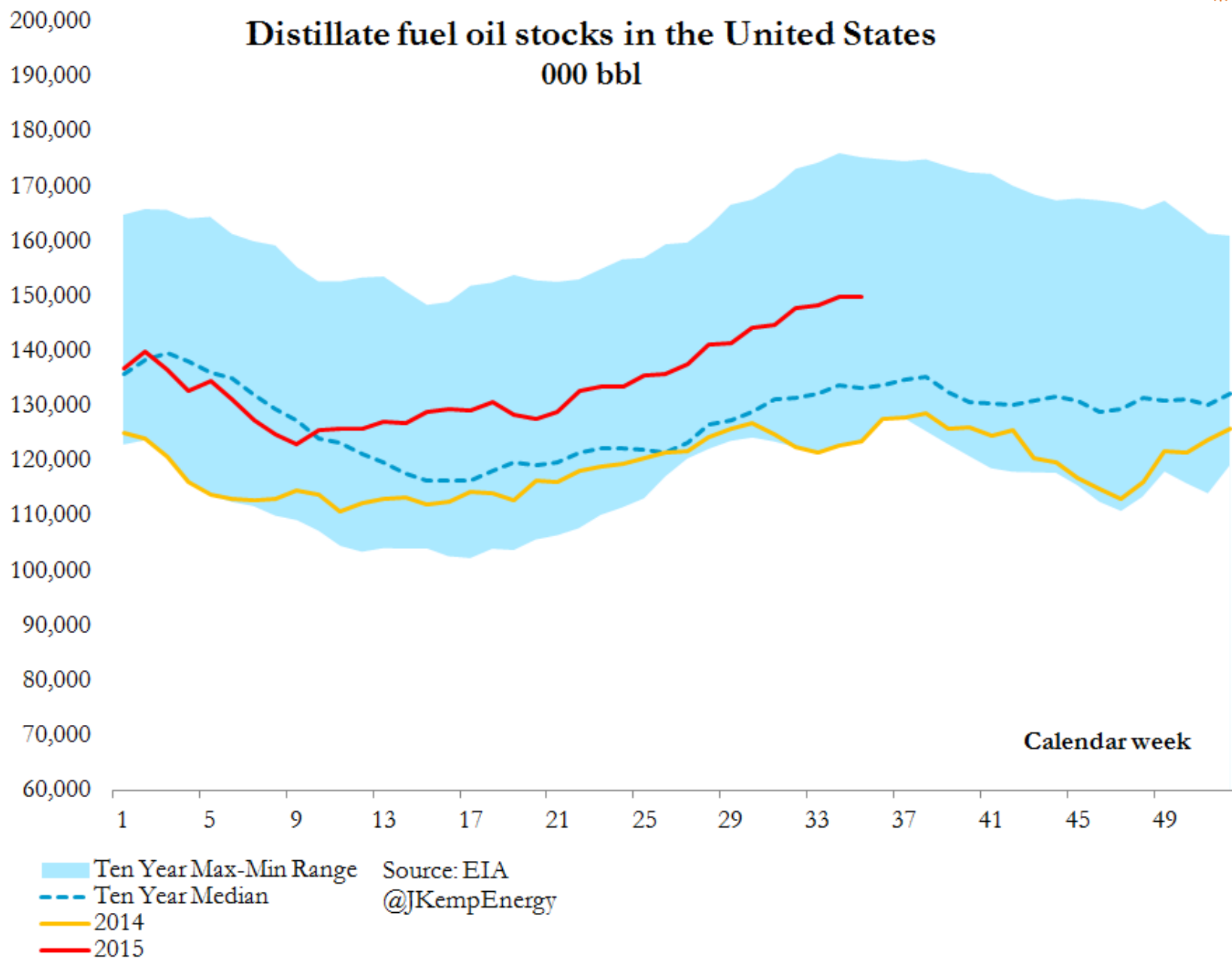

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U.S. gasoline stocks **Days worth of current consumption**

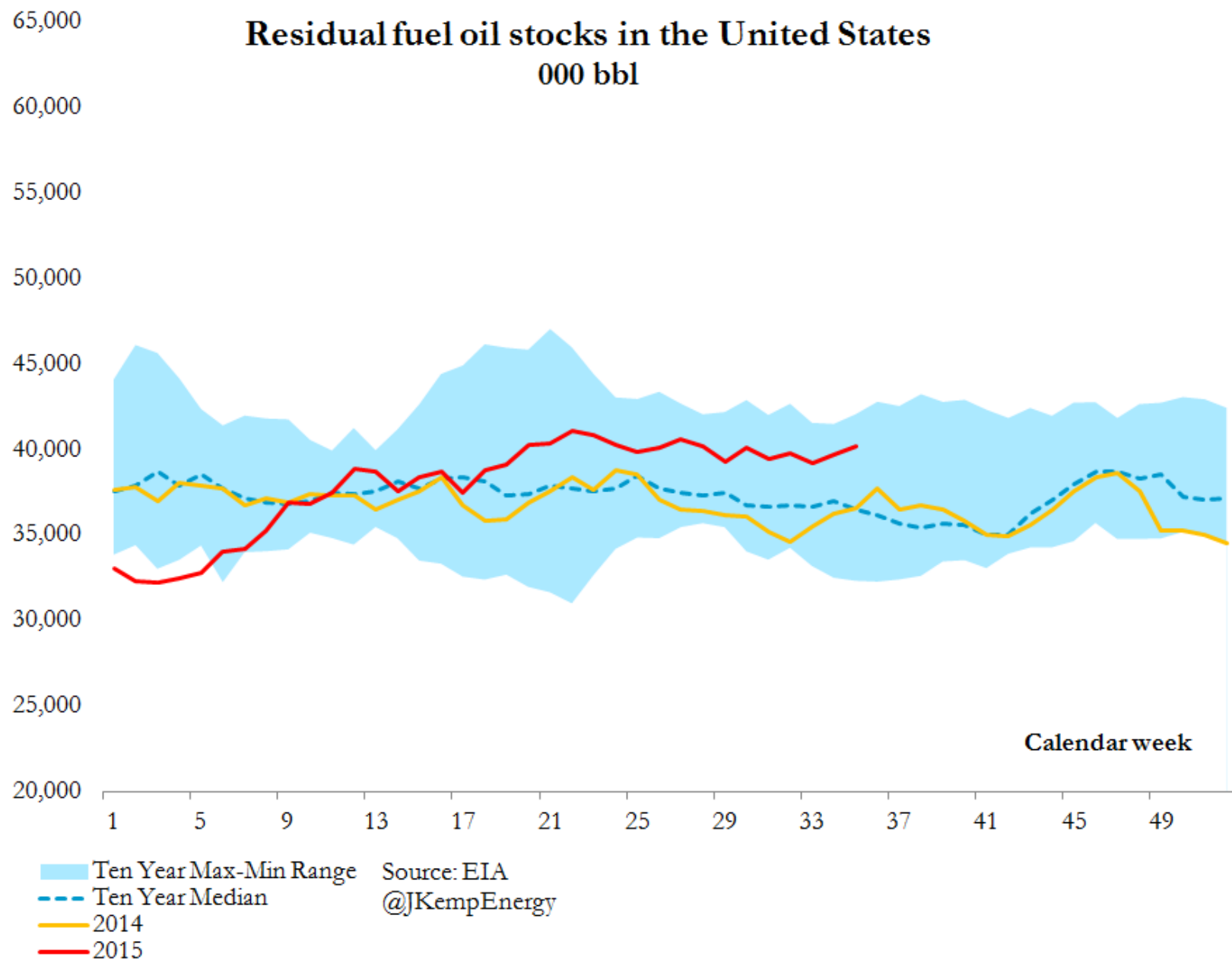


Distillate fuel oil stocks in the United States

000 bbl

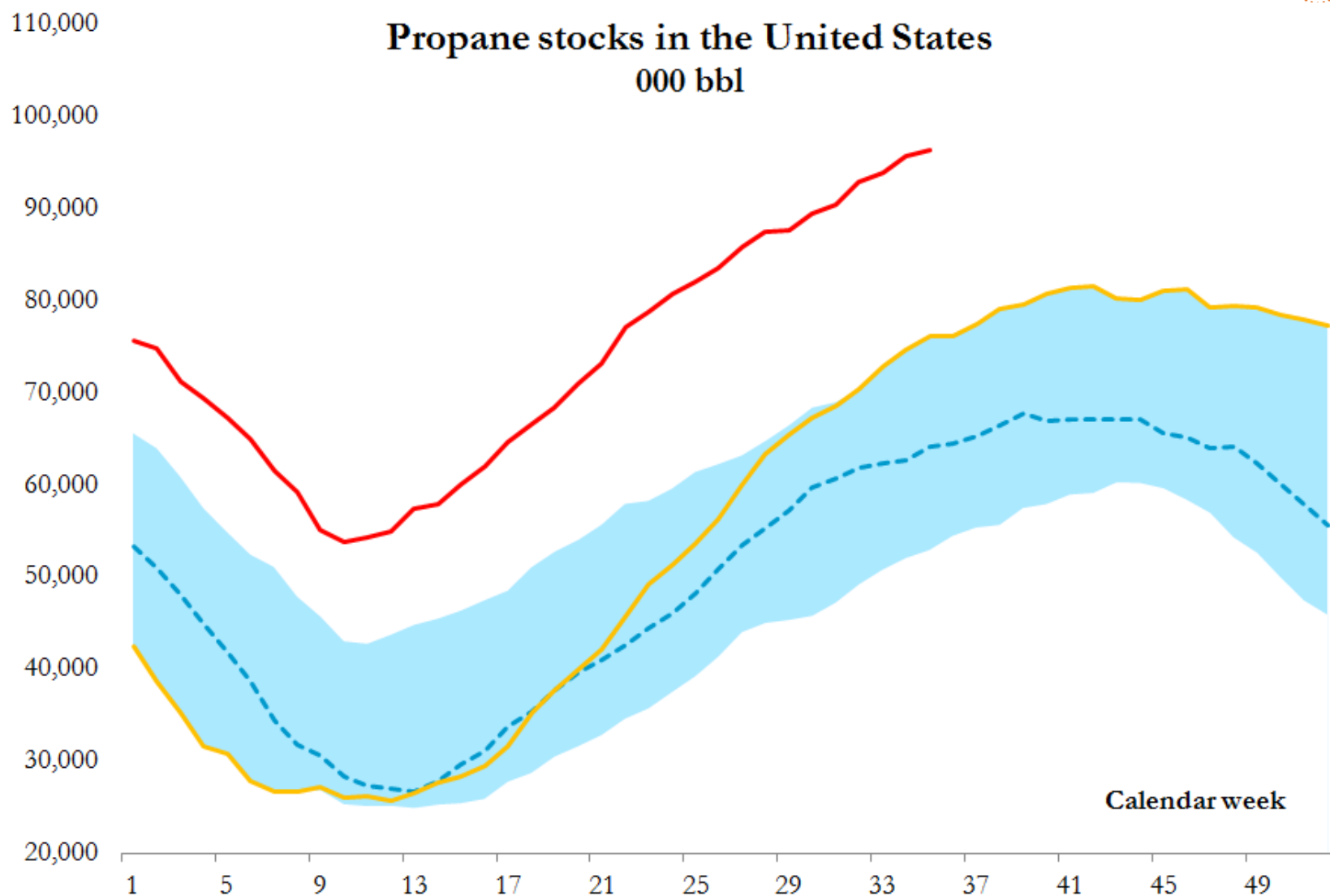


Residual fuel oil stocks in the United States 000 bbl

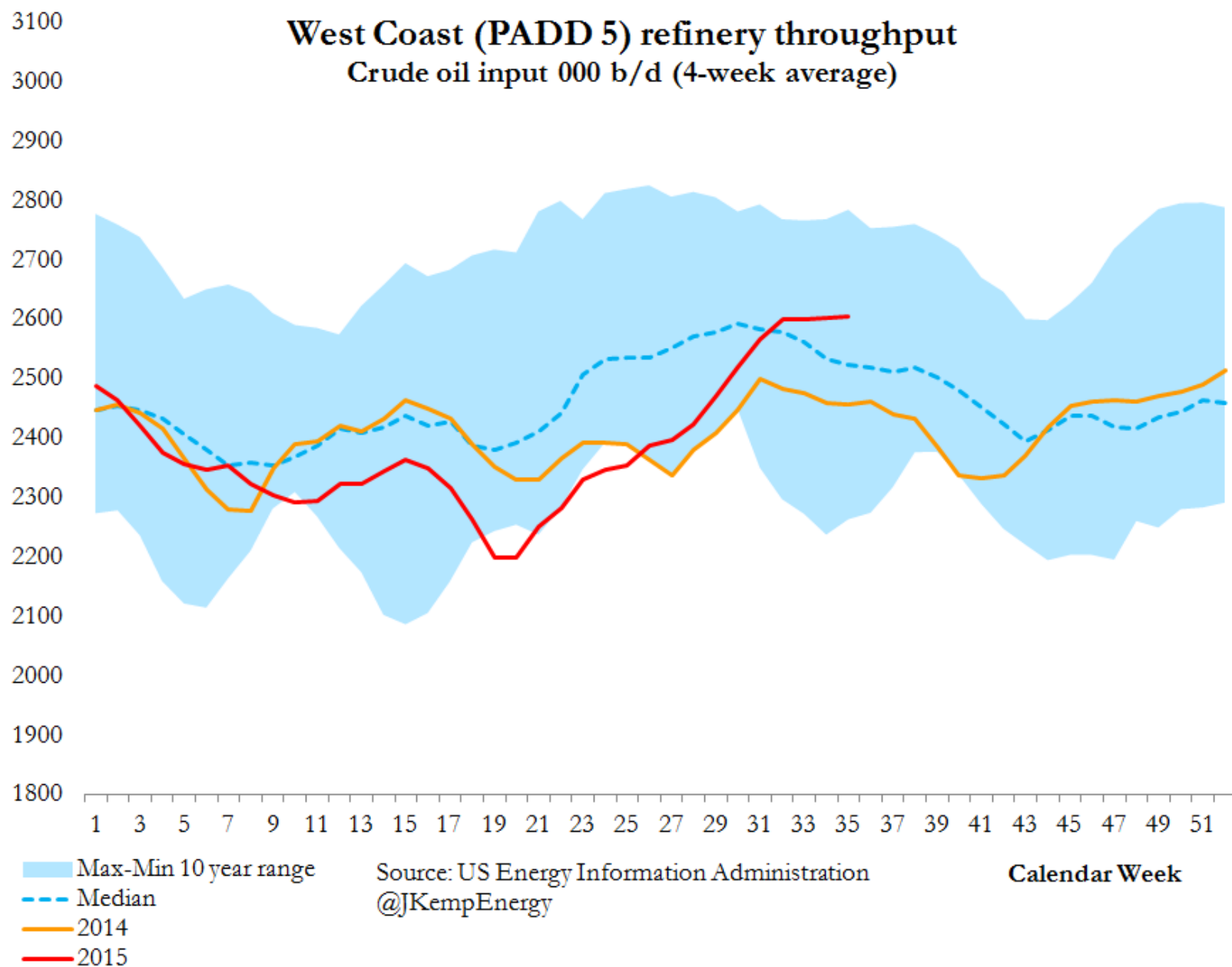
