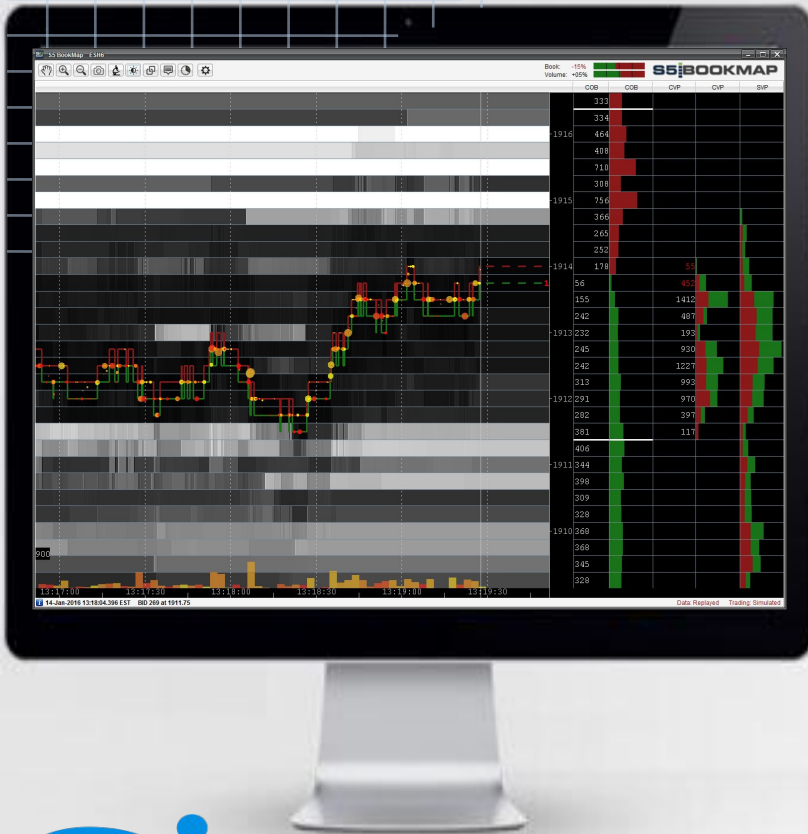

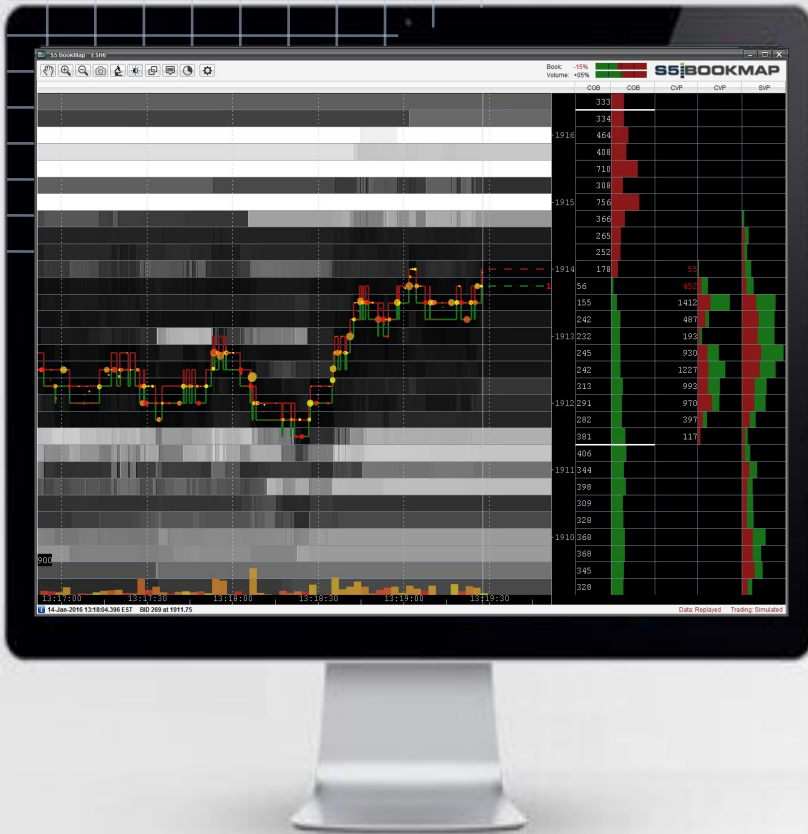

Introduction to Bookmap

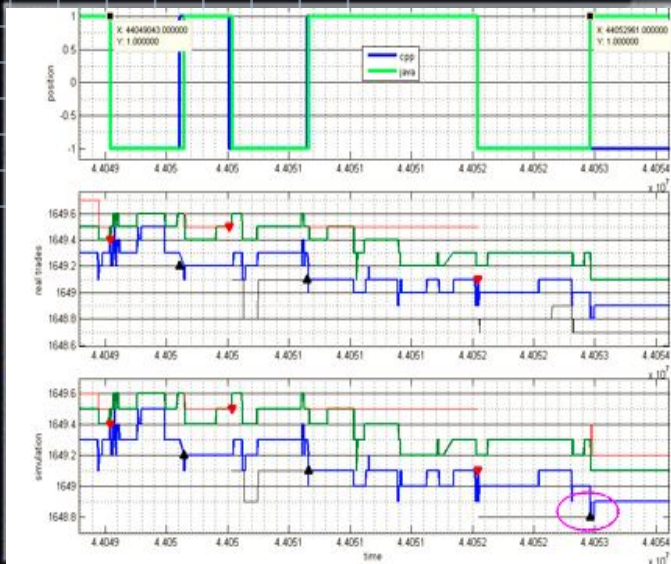
Bookmap was born in the Sub Second environment.

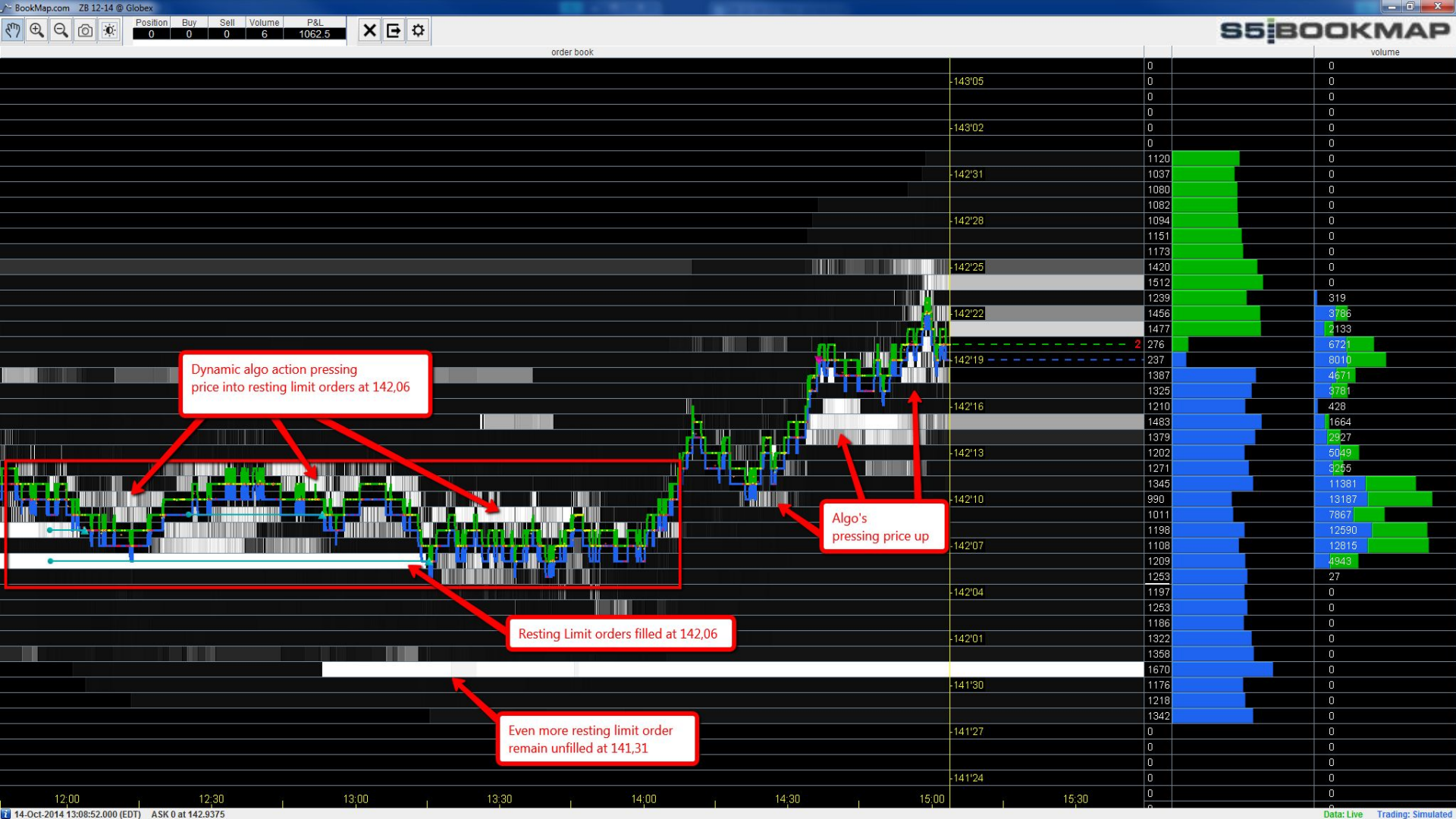


How can you use Bookmap?

 - Does it "Flip and Fill?"





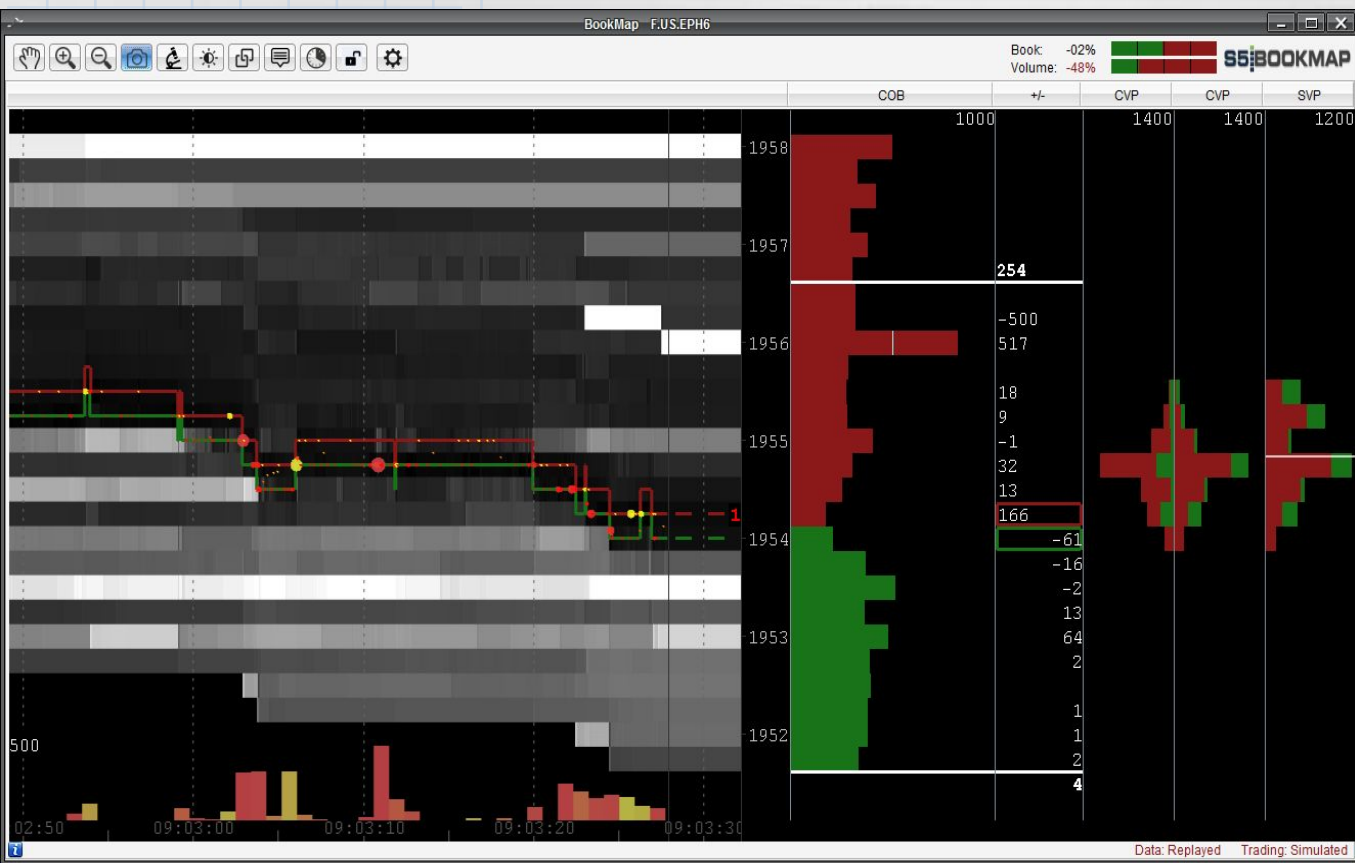

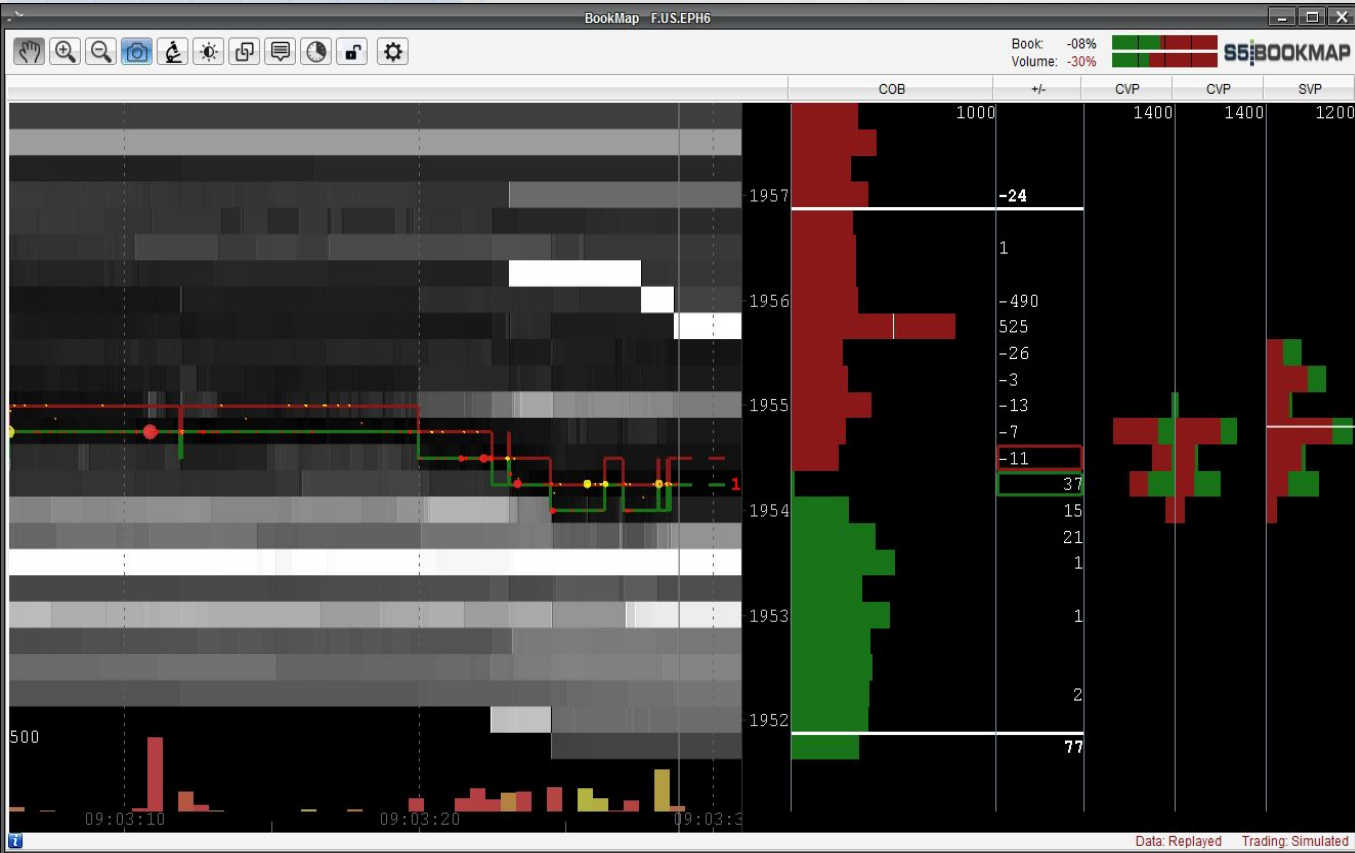

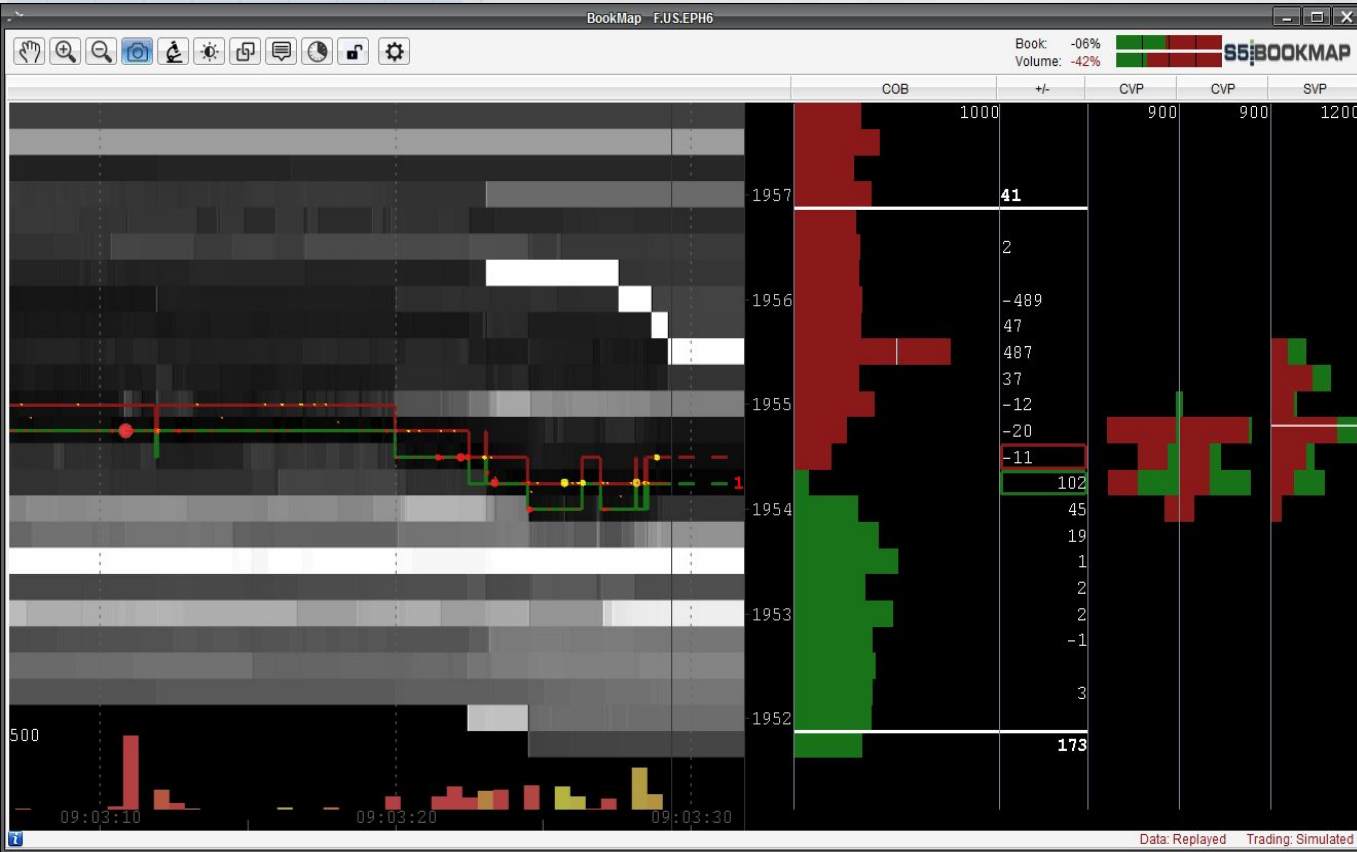
Evolution of the LOB: It's like Seeing the Deck



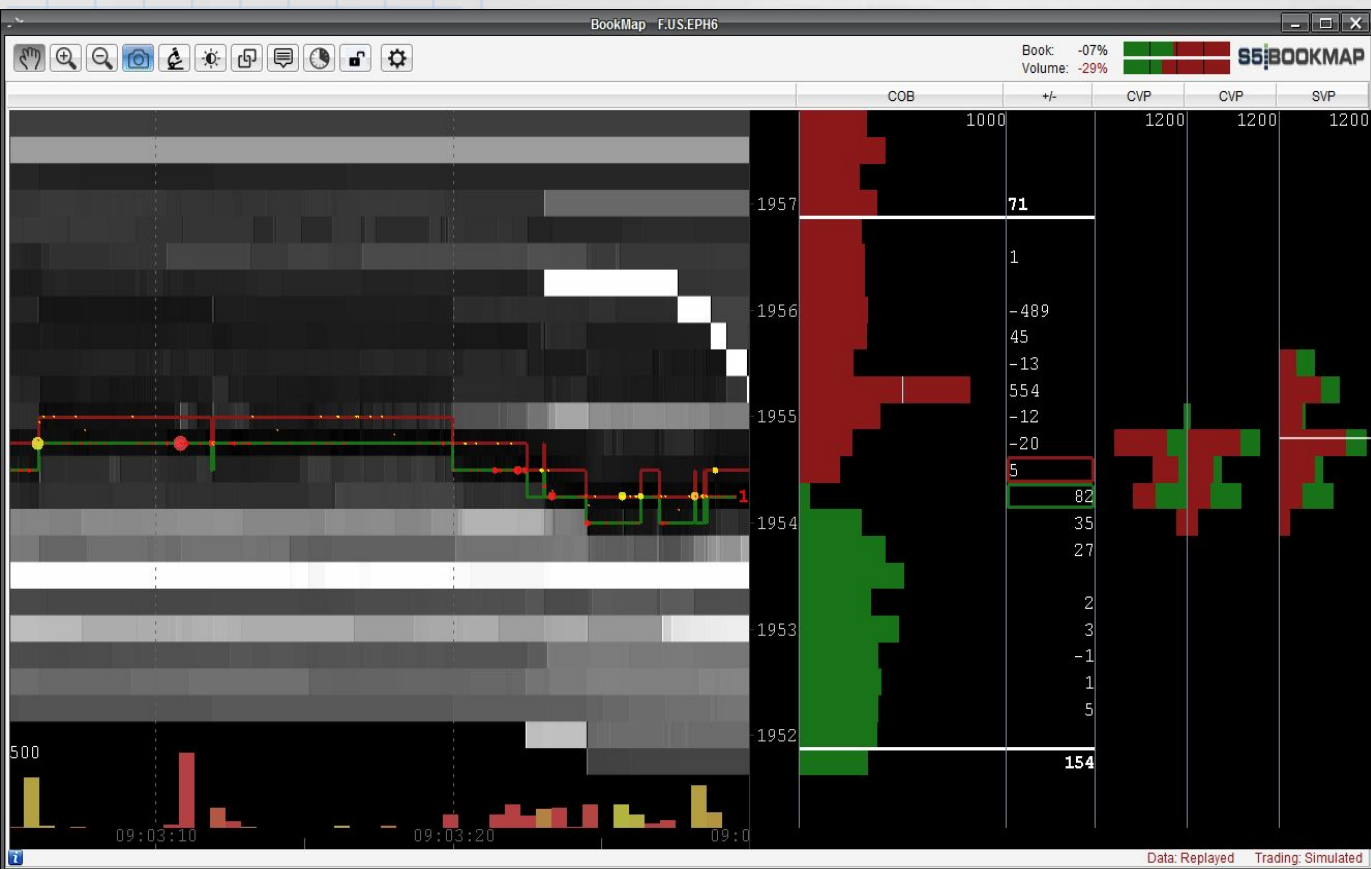

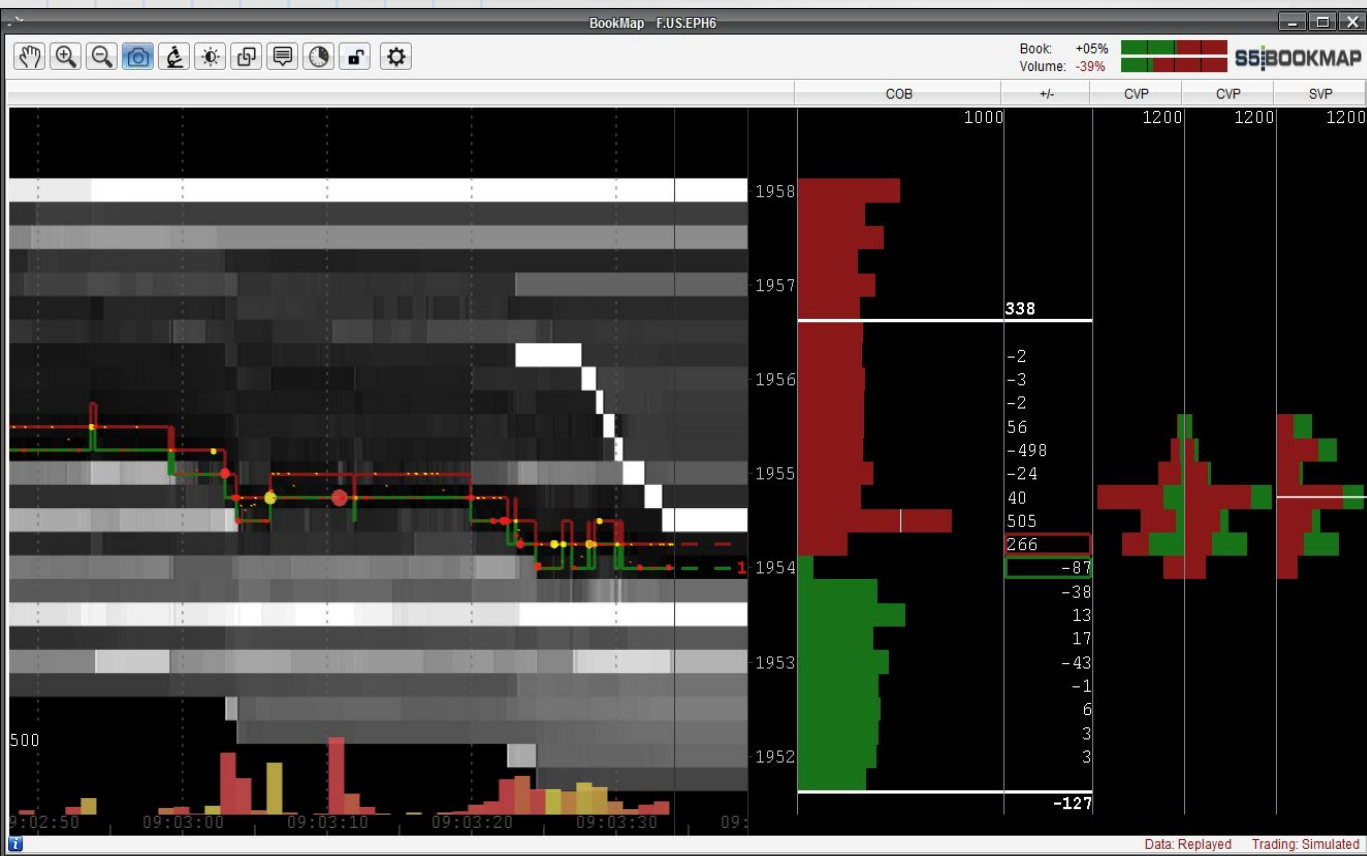

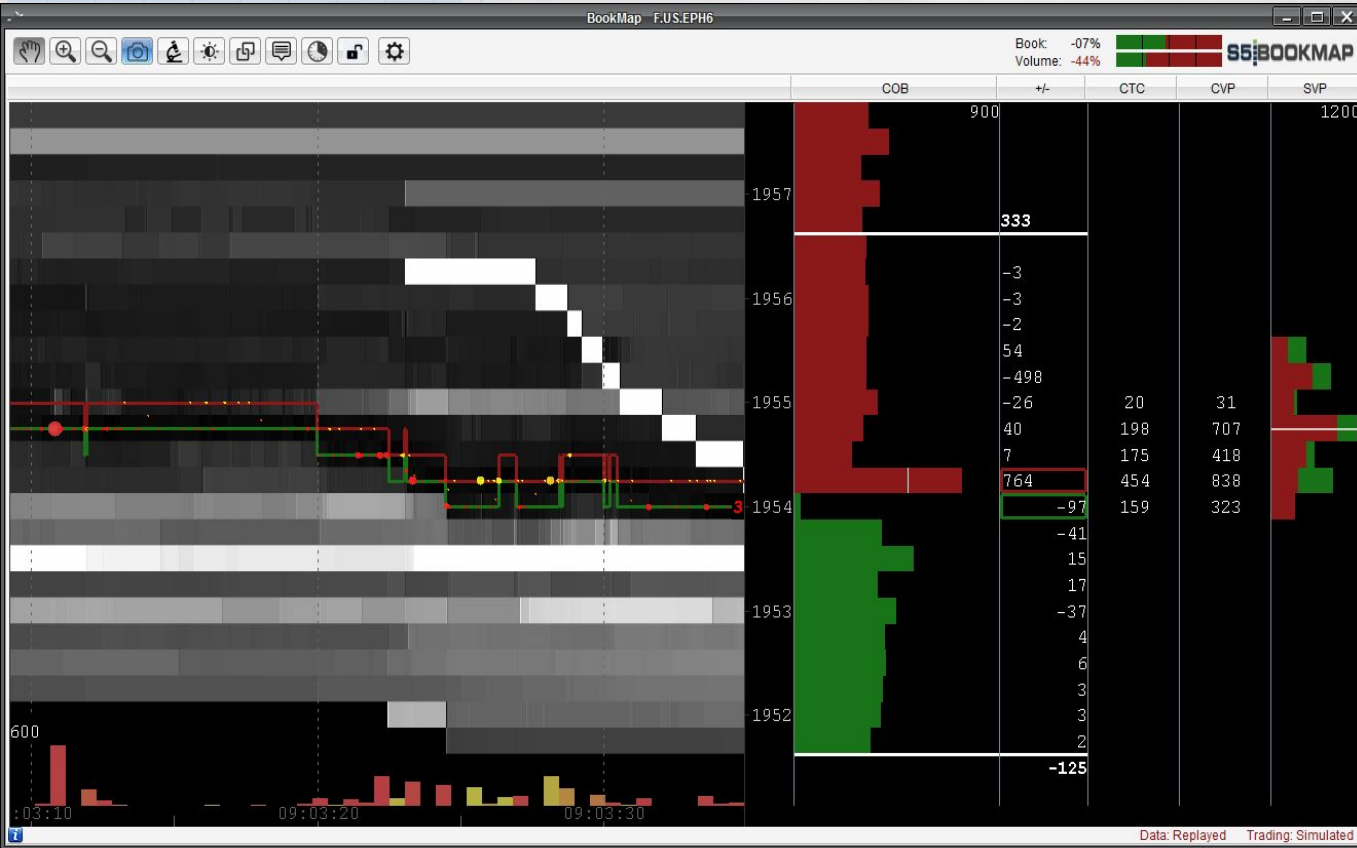
